

Mid March also saw the unveiling of the Interpretive Boards at Lawnton Cemetery. This was a project by the North Pine Historical Society, who applied for a Council grant of \$10K to install four boards showing the cemetery name (pictured), a brief history, a plan of the grave sites and the names of those interred. A lot of work went into the research and presentation and it's a credit to Judy Dohle (pictured), members of the society and some council staff who were involved. For those who don't know the cemetery, it is in Norfolk Ave just off Leis Pde in Lawnton.
