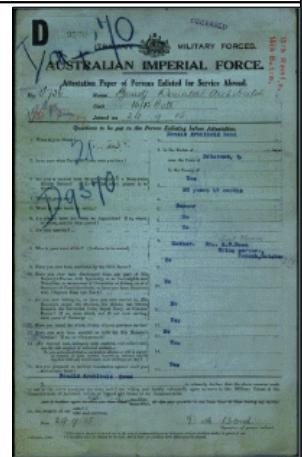

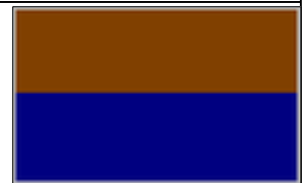

5. He was buried at the Plot J-72 in Bernafay Wood British Cemetery, Montauban, Somme, France on 19 Dec 1916.

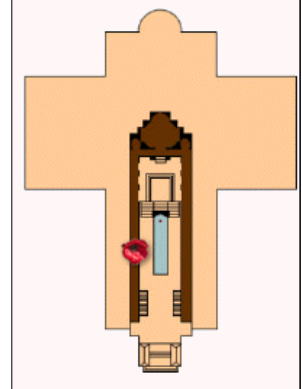


6. Honour Board / Roll of Honour / Memorial: Pine Shire Council Roll of Honour, 1917, Strathpine, Qld, Australia.

8. Military Awards: British War Medal, 1919.



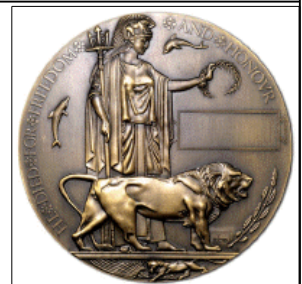
9. Military Awards: Victory Medal, 1919.






Joined A.I.F. and embarked for Egypt. Subsequently left for France, and went into action.
