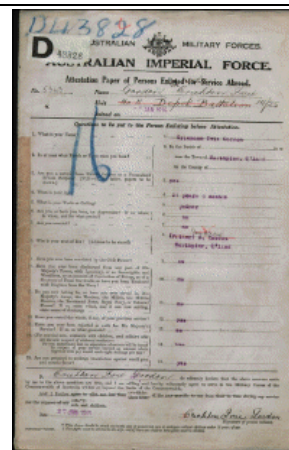

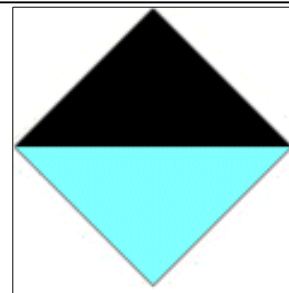

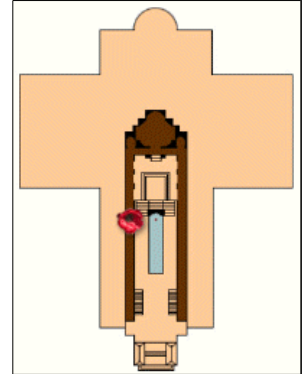

10. Military Awards: Victory Medal, 1919.

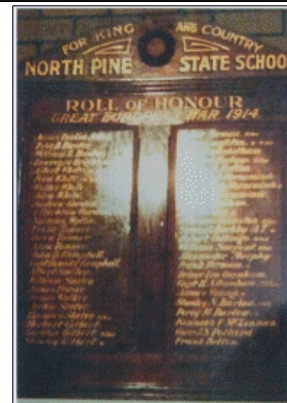

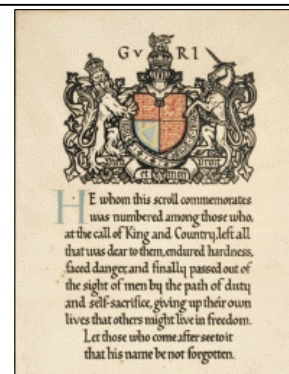

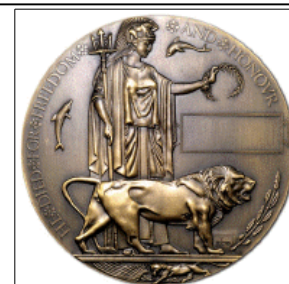
13. Honour Board / Roll of Honour / Memorial: "Where the Australians Rest", 17 May 1922,

General:

GORDON, Chrichton Ivie. Private, No. 5343, 25th Battalion. Born and educated at North Pine (also educated at Brisbane Technical College), and was the son of Andrew and Jessie Gordon, of Auchempine, North Pine, Petrie. Enlisted at Brisbane February 2nd, 1916, and went into camp, where he was attached to the 25th Battalion. He sailed for England per S.S. "Itonis," August 8th, 1916, when he went to Salisbury Plains to complete his training. He left for France, and arrived there on December 16th, 1916. He went into the firing line, and was gassed on October 31st, 1917, at Ypres, and evacuated to England. He rejoined his battalion March 6th, 1918, and was engaged on the Somme until April 16th, 1918, where he died of wounds and was buried near Albert.
