Archibald William <u>S L A T E R.</u> -	<p>For continued acts of gallantry and devotion to duty during the period from 25th February to 17th September, 1918. -</p> <p>Corporal SLATER has during this period been constantly in the Forward Area supervising collection and clearance of salvage.- By his fearless unselfish example, and his concern for their well-being, he kept his squad together under the most trying circumstances, including destruction of their dwelling on six separate occasions. -</p> <p>On 12th April, 1918, near BUIRE, an aeroplane was lying derelict close to the track along which rations were carried. One of the bombs had its detonator exposed. The spot was under enemy observation and, when this H.C.O., started out to salvage the bombs, it was subjected to shell-fire.- He made three trips and salvaged the bombs, thus removing the danger to the ration carriers.</p> <p>Again on two separate occasions in Rue d'AMIENS, VILLERS BRETONNEUX, he went out under shell-fire, and brought in men who had been wounded in the street. -</p>		THE DISTINGUISHED CONDUCT MEDAL.
